1 Manually Audit Deal Jackets

Tina Cruise handles registration & title at Greenwood Automotive. Her title audits involve searching for discrepancies, correcting errors, and printing final copies for the deal jacket. This can take her 25 minutes per deal jacket.

2 Pay Taxes And Fees by Check

Tina enters the amounts owed to the County Clerk into her DMS system by hand. She then takes the checks to her signer. It can take up to 4 days for signed checks to come back to her.

3 Mail Paperwork to The DMV

To get everything to the DMV, Tina must attach checks to the title work, enter shipping info for each deal into her DMS, print labels, package the title work, and mail it through UPS or USPS.

4 Combined, This Process Can Take Up to 20 Days
